Postgraduate Certificate Course

In order for a postgraduate certificate to be awarded, students would have to pass the 4 modules below. The postgraduate certificate course carries **60 academic credits**. The course is studied and assessed at **level 7** of the UK qualifications scale.

Postgraduate Certificate Modules Studied

1. Energy Economics (15 credits)
2. Energy Management & Policy (15 credits)
3. Human Resource Management (15 credits)
4. Principles of Oil & Gas Exploration (15 credits)

The Postgraduate certificate is awarded by the **Trans-Atlantic College**, London.

Postgraduate Diploma Course

In order to be awarded the postgraduate diploma, students must successfully complete the 4 postgraduate certificate modules above and the 4 postgraduate diploma modules (i.e. a total of 8 modules) below. The postgraduate diploma course carries **120 academic credits**. The course is studied and assessed at **level 7** of the UK qualifications scale.

Postgraduate Diploma Modules Studied

5. Energy Law (15 credits)
6. Waste & Environmental Management (15 credits)
7. Disaster Management and Preparedness (15 credits)
8. Strategic Management and Marketing (15 credits)

The postgraduate diploma is awarded by the **Trans-Atlantic College**, London.

Master of Science (MSc) Degree

In order to be awarded the MSc degree, students must have successfully completed the 8 modules (i.e. 4 modules of the postgraduate certificate and the 4 modules of the postgraduate diploma modules) plus the Research Methods and Dissertation modules. The MSc programme carries **180 academic credits**. The course is studied and assessed at **level 7** of the UK qualifications system.

Modules Studied

9. Research Methods (15 credits)
10. Dissertation (45 credits)

The MSc degree is awarded by **Universidad San Juan de la Cruz, Costa Rica**

Course Delivery and Attendance

The course is delivered in a variety of methods, including direct lectures, case studies, tutorials and group work.

Assessment

Assessment of this course is based on Essay-based written assignments, reports, presentations, research projects and direct examinations.

Entry Requirements

Applicants should:-

- a) Hold recognised degree in any subject area; or
- b) Hold an appropriate recognised professional qualification; or
- c) Hold a qualification lower than the ones above, but have at least 2 years appropriate management experience; or
- d) Hold no formal qualifications, but have at least 8 years appropriate management experience; plus
- e) Meet the English Language requirements below.

English Language Requirements

To be considered for admission, you must show competence in spoken and written English, in addition to meeting the entry requirements above.
